Morf Transit Now Offering Stretcher Van Service

Morf Transit is announcing its new non-emergency stretcher van service. “This is a service that the community has needed for some time now.” says company President Paul Robar. “We are living in a ever aging society and with that comes more people with mobility-related disabilities. These people have just as much need and right for transportation as any other person. Currently the only alternative for a bed ridden individual in our area is to ride by ambulance, which is extremely expensive.”

“Recently my Mother-In-law needed to be transported after a hip injury, I was astonished by what the charges for that ride were. It was almost \$500 to have her transported across town from the Medical Center to the Starr Farm. That was when I decided that there needed to be a better solution. Having to pay the cost of full ambulance service, when all that was needed was basic transportation was frustrating.”

This new service will focus on customers with non-emergency transportation needs only. “This is not a ambulance service.” says Paul. “This service is for people who can't ride sitting upright in a wheelchair or seat, but don't require the life support service that an ambulance provides.” By only providing transportation, not unnecessary service and equipment, the cost per trip is significantly reduced. “Don't get me wrong, the ambulances in our area do an excellent job and there are people that really need the services they provide even for basic transportation, but there has been a long standing need for some middle ground between a wheelchair van and an ambulance and we aim to provide that.”
